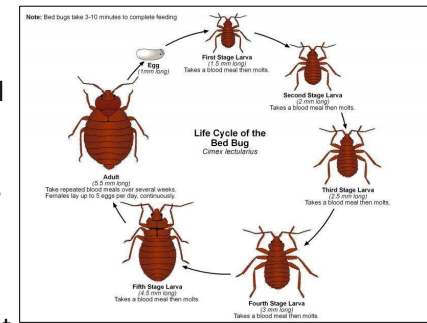

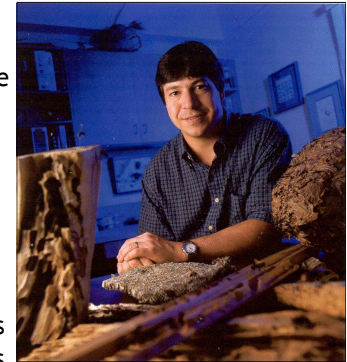

Mr. Cooper has is frequently quoted by the media and has been featured as an expert on National Public Radio (NPR), NBC Dateline, CBS's The Early Show, NBC's Today Show, The Dr. Oz Show, and the Discovery Channel. In 2009 he was appointed to the NYC Bed Bug Advisory Board by Mayor Michael Bloomberg.
